This article will guide you through the process to bulk link issues with Exporter. With just a few clicks you will be able to link as many issues you want to a third one.



Step 1: Go to Exporter from the JIRA Issue Navigator and select issues that you want to export

1. Once you have the results of the filters in the Issue Navigator, click on **Exporter Button**



2. Once you are in the first Exporter Screen you can uncheck the issues that you don't want to export, by default all the issues are selected. **Click on "Continue with # issues"**

Step 2: The format selection screen

1. The second step is to select the format of the export. Between all of them, **select Link to issue**.
2. You can choose between creating a [New Issue](#) (only Server) or to select an [existing one](#).
3. **Click on "Continue with # issues"**


